Why Haiti?

Children die by the thousands from childhood diseases for which cures have existed for decades.



Medical services are difficult to obtain or too expensive for most Haitians to afford. There is only one doctor for every 10,000 Haitians.

The average life expectancy in Haiti is about 49 years of age.

Many children like the one seen here suffer from malnutrition. Many never see their 5th birthday.

Primitive homes with dirt floors are common in rural Haiti and contribute to many diseases such as tuberculosis which is a leading cause of death in Haiti.



Haiti remains the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere.



Disease and infections are common and are usually caused by unsanitary water.

Potable water is difficult to find and the water they do find has been contaminated by raw sewage that runs through the streets.



HOUSING

When we first visited this orphanage, a few miles outside of the Capital, the children lived in this "home" of tin & plywood

with a dirt floor. It was very overcrowded and barely protected them from the elements. The children had "orange hair," a sign of advanced malnutrition.

Malnutrition is all too common in Haiti. Thousands of lives are lost each year!

Now, because of Practical Compassion, the children have a new cement block home and receive food & vitamins everyday. The signs of malnutrition are no longer apparent.
